We planted two tomato plants in grow bags. Sam and Robyn were fascinated with the root system of the plants.














#### We have recently signed up with HM Noticeboard Government for Tax Free Childcare. This is a **new online** Government service to help parents pay for childcare. For every £8 a parent pays in to their childcare account, the Government will add an extra £2, which equates to 20% of the overall We have now introduced a cost.
